## Riverview Catholics Funeral Music Planning

Our Lord Christ the King Church

Dear friends in Christ,

Please be assured that you, your loved one, and your family and friends will be in our thoughts and prayers during this difficult time of loss and going forward. Nothing about planning a funeral is easy, but we will be beside you and do everything we can to make this easier.

There are many opportunities for music and singing in a Catholic Mass of Christian Burial or funeral. The options can become overwhelming. So, let us focus on four points in the liturgy that require music:

- The *Entrance* is sung as the family processes into the church with the ministers.
- The Offertory is sung as gifts of bread and wine are brought to the altar and prepared for the Eucharist.
- The *Communion* is sung as people receive the Body and Blood of the Lord Jesus.
- The Final Commendation at the conclusion of the liturgy.

The music list on the following page has recommended music selections from the *St. Michael Hymnal* and *Music Supplement*. The selections in **Bold type** come directly from the Roman Catholic *Mass of Christian Burial* and *Funeral Rites*. They are sung in Latin or English, and translations for the Latin are in the hymnal. They are the Church's preferred choices for the funeral Mass. The music list also offers an assorted number of musical choices for each music selection in the liturgy. You may use music not found on the list, but it must be appropriate for the Catholic funeral liturgy and approved by the pastor and music director. If there are requests, you may list them in the form for approval. It is recommended to have requests used at preparation of gifts or for communion music.

If the lyrics and music of a request are not contained in the hymnal or supplement, you will need to print lyrics in the funeral program provided by the funeral home, or make a lyric sheet insert.

We will always provide the organist and cantor. Guest organists or cantors are usually not permitted except in very special circumstances. If a family member or guest musician wishes to contribute music, one selection may be permitted. Please consult the music director for further details.

The musical setting of the responsorial psalm, the service music for funeral, i.e. the acclamation before the Gospel, the Eucharistic Acclamations and Lamb of God, and the Song of Farewell are chosen by the music director based on the season of the liturgical year. If you have any questions about these selections, please contact my office.
